



## FACULTY POSITIONS IN THE PRE-BUSINESS PROGRAM

The **Richard Ivey School of Business** is recognized worldwide for the quality of its management education and research. The School's major activities include: a highly regarded MBA program and undergraduate program; a well established doctoral program active in most major areas of management; as well as, an expanding portfolio of programs for executives, including an Executive MBA delivered in Canada and Hong Kong. The School is internationally oriented in terms of curricula, research, faculty, and student exchanges.

The **Ivey Business School** at Western University seeks candidates for Limited Term appointments at the rank of Lecturer in the Pre-Business Program. The start date of these appointments is September 1, 2015. Successful candidates will be required to attend paid training, on a full-time basis in May and June, 2015 and a Case Writing Workshop in August 2015. The appointments are expected to be September 2015 to April 2017. Applicants must have a four-year honours (HBA) degree in commerce/business administration or an MBA degree. Experience and familiarity with the case method is required.

Successful candidates will be required to teach up to three sections of Business 2257 or Business 1220E respectively during the winter and/or summer academic sessions in each of their two years, using the case method of instruction. These courses are developed and taught by the Ivey Business School and available to students across the University. Business 2257 is a required course for Ivey's selective undergraduate (HBA) program. Successful candidates are expected to write a minimum of two cases with comprehensive teaching notes for the Business 2257 or Business 1220E course. Successful candidates are responsible for all activities related to teaching the course curriculum development, writing and setting of exams, managing competitions, training new Lecturers, managing and recruiting teaching assistants and provide academic guidance to students. Some travel is required in the second year of the appointment. Vacation entitlements must be taken in July and August 2016.

These positions are subject to budget approval. Applicants should have fluent written and oral communication skills in English. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be given priority. The Richard Ivey School of Business and The University of Western Ontario are committed to employment equity and welcomes applications from all qualified women and men, including visible minorities, aboriginal people and persons with disabilities.

Please include in your submission an application letter with resume; a transcript of your grades received in your last three full years at university; a detailed description of your experience with the case method.
