Application

Required Documents

- Course selection form
- Copy of passport
- Copy of official transcript
- TOEFL/IELTS score for non-native speakers or any equivalent certificate approved by home institutions
- Housing and arrival form

Language Requirement

- TOEFL a score of 80 or higher on the TOEFL iBT or 550 or higher on the paper-based exam, or
- IELTS a score of 6.0 or higher on the academic module

Course Load

Undergraduate Level

- Maximum 6 courses (18 credits) per semester
- 3 credits equal to 3 class hours per course per week
- Approximately 16 weeks per semester

Graduate Level

- Maximum 3 courses (9 credits) per semester
- Extra course registration will be considered on a case-by-case basis
- 3 credits equal to 3 class hours per course per week
- Approximately 16 weeks per semester
