Course Load	<p>Undergraduate Level</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Maximum 6 courses (18 credits) per semester ● 3 credits equal to 3 class hours per course per week ● Approximately 16 weeks per semester <p>Graduate Level</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Maximum 3 courses (9 credits) per semester ● Extra course registration will be considered on a case-by-case basis ● 3 credits equal to 3 class hours per course per week ● Approximately 16 weeks per semester
