LEARNING **EXPECTATIONS**

CLASS FORMAT

Most are Lecture/Discussion courses. Exams, Personal Dissertations and Oral Presentations.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is mandatory and often taken into account for the final grade. Additionally all testable materials are covered in class.

PARTICIPATION

Participation can count for up to 30% of the final grade.

GRADING

Grades range from 0-10, with 10 as the highest grade, and 5 as the passing grade. Pass=5, Good=6-7, Very Good= 8, Excellent= 9, Honors=10 Letters are also shown in transcripts: A+= Excellent, A= Very good, B= Good, C= Satisfactory, D= Pass, F= Fail

COURSE LOAD FOR LOCAL FULL TIME STUDENTS

30 ECTS/semester

No minimum or maximum workload is required for exchange students.
