

Faculty Positions in Managerial Accounting and Control

The **Ivey Business School** at Western University seeks candidates for two faculty positions in **Managerial Accounting and Control** to begin in July 2014. Applicants for a Probationary (tenure-track) appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor, or a Tenured appointment, at the rank of Associate Professor or Professor must hold a doctorate degree, or equivalent. (Candidates for the probationary position may be nearing completion of their doctorate.) The successful candidate will demonstrate a strong commitment to the practice of accounting and/or management in both research and teaching. The ability to teach introductory financial and/or management accounting courses in Ivey's degree-granting programs is essential. The successful candidate for the probationary appointment will show potential for, or have demonstrated excellence in accounting and control research. Applicants for a Tenured appointment must have demonstrated strengths in accounting and control research with impactful publications, as well as case teaching experience. The ability to teach executive development programs in Canada, Hong Kong and China is valued. Candidates with research supportive of the School's Centres and Institutes are preferred (http://www.ivey.uwo.ca/faculty/centres/). Well-qualified applicants for Limited Term or Visiting appointments at the rank of Lecturer, Assistant, Associate, or Professor will also be considered.

The School values managerially relevant research that has impact and is publishable in the leading journals, and the accounting group is particularly interested in building expertise in qualitative, historical and behavioral research. Successful candidates will be expected to teach financial and/or managerial accounting subjects in our student-centered, case-based undergraduate, MBA, or EMBA programs, or in the MSc or PhD programs. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, under Canadian immigration requirements, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be given priority.
