

## Faculty Position in Corporate Sustainability - Any Business Discipline

The **Ivey Business School** at Western University seeks candidates for a Probationary (tenure-track) appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor, or a Tenured appointment, at the rank of Associate Professor with research interests consistent with the areas of corporate sustainability or responsibility to begin in July 2015. A Limited Term appointment at the rank of Lecturer, Assistant, Associate, or Professor also will be considered.

The successful candidate will contribute to the school's research focus on the corporate actions that concurrently manage both public and private interests, which supports the school's research centre on Building Sustainable Value (http://www.ivey.uwo.ca/centres/building/).

The successful candidate will teach corporate sustainability or responsibility and may also be called upon to teach core courses within his/her disciplinary area. The School will consider qualified candidates from all areas of business. However, preference will be given to candidates from accounting, finance, information technology, management science, marketing, and operations, given the school's teaching needs. A willingness to teach executive development programs in Asia is valued.

TENURED POSITION: Applicants for a tenured appointment at the rank of Associate Professor or Professor will hold a PhD (or equivalent degree). The ideal candidate will have demonstrated the ability to publish in the highest quality academic outlets and is a recognized expert in his or her field of research. Demonstrated ability to successfully teach in core undergraduate and/or MBA courses using a case discussion format is required.

UNTENURED POSITION: Applicants for a probationary (tenure-track) appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor must already have, or be nearing completion of their doctorate. Candidates should have a strong academic background and the ability to publish in the highest quality academic outlets. The ability to teach in core undergraduate and/or MBA courses using a case discussion format is essential.

LIMITED TERM POSITION: Applicants for a Limited Term appointment are expected to hold at least a Masters' degree. The successful candidate will have demonstrated excellence in case teaching in core undergraduate and/or MBA courses using a case discussion format.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Applicants are encouraged to submit materials (curriculum vitae, three letters of recommendation and copies of research papers) online to <a href="mailto:faculty/career-opportunities/">faculty/career-opportunities/</a> for other application details). Review of applicants will commence on September 30, 2014 and applications will be considered until the position is filled.
