I'd like to share with you a few of our milestones, both in Asia and globally:

- Ivey ranked 19th among business schools worldwide, and tops in Canada (*Financial Times* MBA 2000 Rankings)
- Ivey ranked among the top business schools worldwide for Executive Education Programs and tops in Canada. (*Financial Times* 2000 Ranking of top Executive Development programs worldwide)
- Ivey is the # 2 business school worldwide for teaching materials development – External sales rose 46% in the past year.
- Ivey's first Hong Kong based Executive MBA class graduated in October. Ivey was the 1st North American business school to build a campus in Asia.
