Abstract:

Nigel Dodd is a Cambridge University-trained sociologist and currently professor at the London School of Economics and Political Science. Dodd's interest in money as a subject of sociological inquiry spans his academic career. His first book on the topic, The Sociology of Money: Economics Reason and Contemporary Society, was published in Citation1994. The Social Life of Money is Dodd's second book following similar themes of inquiry. There are plans for a third, Utopianism and the Future of Money. The third volume is intended to draw on ideas that connect money with Utopianism, a link that Dodd presents in this present work, and the possibilities for monetary reform.
