Nomination procedure	Student must be nominated via correspondence from their home university to Bond University's Exchange Office on <a href="mailto:exchange@bond.edu.au">exchange@bond.edu.au</a> . Once nominated, the student will be contacted by Bond with instructions to submit an online application.
Nomination deadlines	Semester 1 (January - April, 2019) nominations due by 1 September, 2018 Semester 2 (May - August, 2019) nominations due by 15 February, 2019 Semester 3 (September - December, 2019) nominations due by 15 April, 2019

## Application Procedures

Application procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Exchange Officer at Bond receives email from partner institution with details of nominated student/s</li> <li>Email response sent to partner institution. Acceptance will be based on agreement type and current exchange balance</li> <li>Students must then complete Bond University online application <a href="http://apply.bond.edu.au">apply.bond.edu.au</a></li> <li>Student will select six to eight Bond subjects for approval via the online application</li> <li>Once the application is submitted, it will be assessed within two to four weeks</li> <li>Student will be notified of their application outcome via email</li> <li>Student must sign and return the Response to Offer and make payment for Students Activities Membership and Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC)</li> <li>Bond will then issue a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE). Student will require the CoE document to apply for a student visa</li> </ol>
Application deadlines	Applications for Semester 1 (January - April 2019) are due by 15 September, 2018 Applications for Semester 2 (May - August 2019) are due by 1 March, 2019 Applications for Semester 3 (September - December 2019) are due by 1 May, 2019
Required / supporting documents	Academic transcript, grading scale, English Language Proficiency documents (if required), formal nomination and copy of photo page of passport

2018 Overseas Health Cover (OSHC)	AUD \$275 for five months cover*  Bond's preferred provider of OSHC is Allianz Global Assistance - <a href="https://oshcallianzassistance.com.au">oshcallianzassistance.com.au</a> . When applying for a student visa, students will be required to upload the CoE document as evidence of their OSHC insurance (excluding students from Belgium, Norway and Sweden).

Visa	Australian Government Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) - <a href="https://border.gov.au">border.gov.au</a>  Student Visa (subclass 500) Information: <a href="https://border.gov.au/Trav/Visa-1/500-">border.gov.au/Trav/Visa-1/500-</a>  <b>Student visas are preferred as students cannot receive OSHC on non-student visa.</b>  If a student is coming in on any category of visa other than a student visa, this must be made known to the Exchange Officer. Approval for a student visa can take up to four weeks. Students are advised not to book flights until their visa is approved.
