Congratulations to the Ivey HBA classes of 2017 and 2018!

This year was another successful year for our graduates as they achieved 94% placement across a variety of industries, functions, geographies and organizations.

Ivey HBA graduates continue to be attracted to the Consulting and Financial Services sectors and placement in these two industries remains strong, accounting for over half of the graduates from the Class of 2017. Ivey students continue to seek an increasingly diverse range of opportunities, based the perception or belief that they can make an impact quickly within these organizations. As a result, placement in other industries including Information Technology, Accounting, Consumer Packaged Goods, Telecommunications and Hospitality Services remain somewhat consistent.

Summer employment offers our students great opportunities to put their first year of HBA into action and explore a new function or industry. For the Class of 2018 seeking summer internships, a full 95 percent of the class received at least one job offer. As internships continue to be valuable for companies to assess a students fit for full-time employment after graduation, this past year, 33% of the graduating class of 2017, translated their summer employment opportunity to a full-time role with the same organization.

This year's graduating class is typical in terms of where their careers are beginning, and indicative of a strong start to what promises to be a progressive and diverse leadership track.

As always, our active network of more than 25,000 alumni and over 460 corporate partners played a central role in our students' success. This report would not be possible without the organizations and alumni who not only trust us with their recruitment efforts, but share market insights that help drive our students' success. Thank you to them for their support and confidence in Ivey talent – we look forward to another great year ahead.




CLASS OF 2017 AT A GLANCE




