- **Fritz Machlup (1962):** *“The Production and Distribution of Knowledge in the U.S.”*
- **Japanese government goal (1971):** *‘Realization of the Information Society’*
- **Daniel Bell (1973):** *“The Coming of Post-Industrial Society”*
- **Edwin Parker (1976)** Professor, Stanford University, Canadian: *“... the fundamental economic shift to the Information Society raises new questions concerning the approach to traditional economic issues”*
 - **First issue of *Telecommunications Policy*, December 1976**
- **Marc Porat (1977)** Stanford grad student: *“The Information Economy: Definition and Measurement”*
 - **First study to define and quantify the “information sector”**
- **Andrew Hardy (1980)** Stanford grad student: *“The Role of the Telephone in Economic Development.”* ***Telecommunications Policy*, 4/4**
 - **One of early studies on the role of information and telecommunications in economic development**
